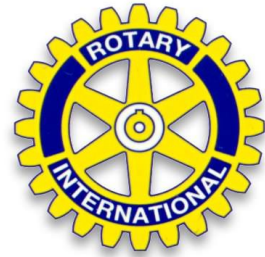

Hi Peter,

We have two of the three community dinner dates locked in from this end and we hope that the dates will suit your members.

The first dinner will be held on Saturday 30 January at the Thoona hall (to the north of Benalla). 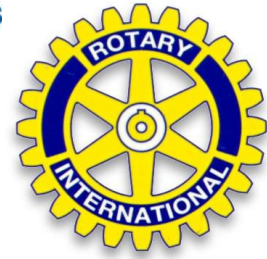
