Susan Carew – Peace Studies in Bangkok.



Susan Carew became interested in Peace Studies at the Latrobe University.

One day, to bring attention to her interest in Peace, she was juggling, trying on wigs and clowning around, when she was observed by a group of Box Hill Rotarians. Susan explains that dressing as a clown is a peace symbol.

Susan is then invited to participate in a Rotarian Peace and Conflict Studies Programme.

She took part in an international conference held at the Chulalongkorn University in Bangkok. There were 19 participants from all around the world. All were experienced in the concept of peace and conflict. The key note speaker was the Norwegian Ambassador.

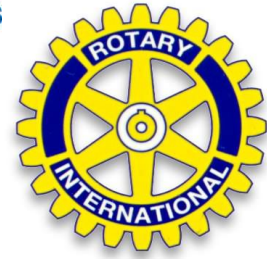
There was consensus of opinion that where conflicts arise, frustration follows. Frustration leads to bullying. Food, safety, identity, and freedom are our most basic needs, and deprivation of these needs lead to conflict. The question is, are we able to meet peoples' needs? Can we stop thinking that fighting is inevitable, and instead think that fighting is preventable?

The participants were taken to North Thailand to inspect refugee camps, then to Cambodia to see the Killing Fields. The Sex Industry in Thailand was also observed.

With so much conflict in the world, can society ever be ruled by kindness?

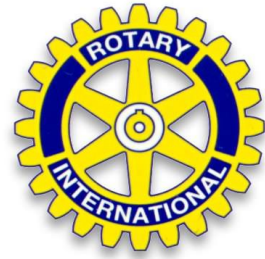

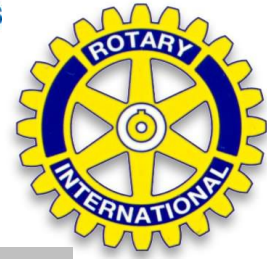
